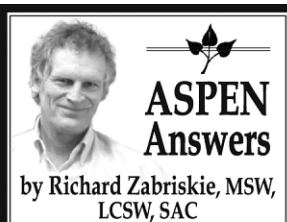

**YOUR MOTHER  
SHOULD KNOW**

Parents generally assume, often rightly so, that they know their children better than anyone else. However, parents should be open to the possibility that they may not be fully aware of their children's behavior. In fact, a recent study indicates that parents are largely unaware that their children are using alcohol or drugs. When researchers asked teens about alcohol and drug use, the three most common substance cited were alcohol (54 percent) tobacco (44 percent), and marijuana (23 percent). When the teens surveyed were asked about their own use of these and other substances, their parents failed to detect usage in about half the cases. The older the child, the more likely the parent was aware of substance abuse.

The most recent Columbia County teen survey shows that age groups (11-13) and (14-15) reveal that 15% and 14% respectively, are engaging in drinking behavior beyond a few sips.
